TECH TIPS

SO WHY DO I NEED A BLOCK HEATER, AND WHAT EXACTLY IS A BLOCK HEATER ANYWAY?

Because you live in Canada and it's cold here in winter! In many areas of our country, temperatures in the winter months can drop between -20°C and -35°C! *Brrrrrr!*

A Block Heater is an appliance, similar to the electrical element in an electric kettle, specifically designed to be installed and operate in the engine of your Subaru.

HOW DOES IT WORK EXACTLY?

Once installed by your Subaru Dealer, the Block Heater should be plugged into a regular 110V electrical outlet early in the morning. This can be accomplished comfortably by having it plugged into a timer the night before, allowing the Block Heater to come on as early as 4.00 – 5.00 a.m.

By the time you are ready to leave the house, the car's cooling system is at or near optimal operating temperature. Immediately after start-up you will be able to feel heat from the car's heater and you will be warm sooner. Also, the snow and ice on your windshield will melt much more quickly, as the temperature of the air being deflected to the inside of the windshield from your defroster is warm right away!

As a result of the engine's coolant being at or near optimal operating temperature, this heat will be transferred from the coolant to the engine's lubricating system, which means the oil, like the coolant, will be much warmer than the sub-zero temperature outside. This relieves the engine's starter from the additional strain of cranking-over the engine with extremely thick (viscous) oil. It also helps the moving parts inside your engine to be properly and adequately lubricated sooner.

Just like the air conditioning system in your Subaru, once you enjoy the benefits of a Block Heater, you will never want to be without one!
