

Why You Should Check Your Oil Regularly

As a Subaru owner you are part of an elite group of driving enthusiasts.

We would like to remind you however, your Subaru is one of the most technologically advanced vehicles on the road today and requires regular maintenance, especially when it is driven enthusiastically, and particularly if your vehicle is equipped with a turbocharged engine.

In that light, we would like to outline for you, a procedure you should follow to check your engine oil level *at least every second fuel fill*. It is very important that your vehicle is at operating temperature and allow the vehicle to sit with the engine shut off for at least five minutes. This will allow the engine oil to completely drain into the oil pan, therefore giving you an accurate reading of just how much oil is in the engine.

If the oil is cold and not up to operating temperature you will get a false reading of the actual amount of oil in the engine, as a lot of the oil will not be able to drain into the oil pan due to the viscosity (thickness) of the oil.

An alternative to checking the oil level when the engine is at operating temperature, is to allow the vehicle to sit overnight, and in the morning, before starting the vehicle, check the oil level. This is the most accurate time to take a reading of the oil in the engine, as indicated on the engine oil dipstick, as all the oil in the engine has had time to drain down in the oil pan.

The engine oil level dipstick is located under the hood, and can be identified by the bright yellow handle with a symbol of an oil can on the top. (Refer to Section 11, Maintenance and Service, in your Owner's Manual for more detailed instructions)

If the oil level is at, or below, the "add oil" mark on the dipstick, add just one (1) litre of oil and recheck the level after a few minutes. Avoid overfilling the engine. The level on the dipstick should NOT exceed the "full" mark on the dipstick, but *should* be above the "add oil" mark.
