Basic Hardware buttons



① MODE button **② MULTI-CONTROL**

Rotate to adjust the audio volume. Pressing this button when the audio source is selected plays the track, file or skips chapter.

③ LIST button

The list lets you see the list of file names or folder names.

(4) SRC/OFF button Selecting the audio source. (5) BAND/ESC button

Changes the band for the radio.

6 **DETACH** button

Press to remove the detachable device from the head unit.

Switching the screen

Scrolling the map

Dragging the map allows scrolling. The scroll speed will change depending on your drag speed.



Setting the volume for navigation system

 Touch Settings on the "Navigation Menu" screen.
Touch Sound.



Pairing your phone

- Activate the Bluetooth function on your phone.
- 2 Touch the keys in the following order; Phone → Settings
- **3** Turn Bluetooth On/Off to On.



4 Touch the keys in the following order; Connections ⇒Add ⇒ Search devices



The system tries to find and lists nearby devices.

5 Touch your phone on the list and then enter the PIN code from your phone. (The PIN code is "1111".) When the pairing is successful, the message will appear.

Transferring the phone book

- Connect the cellular phone.
- 2 Touch Transfer on Phone Menu.



- **3** Touch OK to enter the waiting screen.
- 4 Operate your phone to transfer the phone book entries during waiting screen.
- 5 After transferring, touch OK.

When the transferring is successful, "Completed data loading!" will appear.

Selecting the audio source

- Press the MODE button when the map of the current location is displayed.
- 2 Press the SRC/OFF button repeatedly to switch between the following sources.

XM (XM tuner)⇒SIRIUS (SIRIUS tuner)⇒HD Radio (HD Radio tuner)⇒TUNER (tuner)⇒CD (built-in CD player) ⇒USB (USB storage device)/iPod (iPod connected using USB input)⇒EXT1 (external unit 1)⇒EXT2 (external unit 2)⇒AUX (auxiliary device)⇒XM (XM tuner)

Notes:

- The audio source is disabled if the equipment is not connected or inserted.
- When the tuner has been tuned in to an HD Radio broadcasting, "TUNER" can not be selected.

Tuner source screen



- (1) Shows which band the radio is tuned to: FM1 to FM3.
- 2 Shows what preset item has been selected.
- $\ensuremath{\textcircled{}}$ 3 Shows the frequency.
- ④ Storing and recalling broadcast frequencies

Playing your Apple iPod

You can control an iPod by connecting the USB interface cable for iPod (CD-IU50) (sold separately) to the navigation system.

Connect your iPod.



2 Switch the audio source to iPod.



- ① Text display area
- ② Switches the strings in the text area

$\ensuremath{\textcircled{}}$ Sets iPod control mode.

This navigation system's iPod function can be operated from the connected iPod.

- ④ Playing songs in random order
- 5 Playing songs related to the currently playing song
- Pressing MULTI-CONTROL right or left Skips the track forward or backward.
- Pressing and holding MULTI-CONTROL right or left

Perform fast forward or backward.

 Pressing the center of MULTI-CONTROL

The advanced function screen appears.

• MULTI-CONTROL Rotating

Adjusts the audio source volume.

Pressing LIST button

Shows the list to select a song.
