CHECK THE IF THE ITEM IS OKAY. CHECK THE IF ADJUSTMENTS ARE REQUIRED, AND PROVIDE DETAILS ON THE REPAIR ORDER.

BEFORE ROAD TEST/HOOD OPEN/TRUNK OPEN/ENGINE COLD

UNDER HOOD CHECKS

(Perform appropriate maintenance service according to mileage.)

- 1. Before road test/hood open/trunk open
- 2. Check primary and secondary hood latch operation
- 3. Check radiator and cap
- 4. Check hoses and clamps
- 5. Check air filter
- 6. Change oil filter
- 7. Check drive belt tension and condition

CHECK, TOP OFF, OR CHANGE FLUIDS/CONDITIONS AS REQUIRED:

- 8. Change engine oil
- 9. Check coolant
- 10. Check power steering fluid
- 11. Check brake fluid
- 12. Check clutch fluid (WA)
- 13. Fill windshield washer fluid
- 14. Check I/C water bottle (fill less than 1/2 full during cold weather) (WA)
- 15. Check and clean battery (mounting, cables, and ground straps)
- 16. Check specific gravity
- 17. Check electrolyte level
- 18. Perform load test
- 19. Check spare tire pressure/tool kit/jack and handle
- 20. Inspect front & rear wiper blades

ENTER VEHICLE

INTERIOR COMPARTMENT INSPECTION:

- 21. Insert key in ignition/check chime
- 22. Key "ON" - check dash warning lights
- 23. Turn "ON" rear defogger - check indicator
- 24. Check windshield wipers and washer front/rear (WA)
- 25. Check headlights, high/low alignment
- 26. Check dash illumination control and display
- 27. Check headlight leveler operation (WA)
- 28. Check I/C water spray operation (WA)
- 29. Turn headlights to park position
- 30. Turn "ON" hazard flashers

WA - Where Applicable

- 31. Check reverse lock out (WA)
- 32. Shift transmission to reverse/set parking brake, check adjustment if necessary
- 33. Check clutch/brake pedal free play (WA)
- 34. Check seatbelts/warning lights
- 35. Check for proper movement and operation of both front seats
- 36. Check cold weather package operation (heated seats, mirrors and windshield) (WA)
- 37. Check fuel filler release
- 38. Check lighter and ashtray (WA)
- 39. Check power outlet (WA)
- 40. Check trunk release (WA)
- 41. Check for DTC using select monitor - record if any, clear memory if necessary - leave connected for road test
- 42. Check steering column parking lamp switch operation
- 43. Sound horn
- 44. Check DCCD display and manual mode operation "Reset to automatic mode" (WA)

EXIT VEHICLE & CHECK

- 45. Check fog lamps/aim (WA)
- 46. Check turn signals (front & rear)
- 47. Check parking lamps
- 48. Check license plate lamps
- 49. Check brake and high mount stop lamps
- 50. Check tail lamps
- 51. Check reverse lamps
- 52. Check all front lamps
- 53. Check fuel filler cap operation

OPEN DOOR/IGNITION "OFF"

- 54. Check hazard flashers/parking lamps "Off"

ENTER VEHICLE/IGNITION "ON"

- 55. Check turn signals/indicator lamps
- 56. Check brake lamps
- 57. Check remote mirror operation L/R
- 58. Sit in passenger seat to check airbag "On/Off" and passenger seatbelt warning light (Technician weight must exceed 85 lbs./38 kg or special tool must be used) (WA)
- 59. Set clock
- 60. Check steering lock/tilt
- 61. Check all seat adjustments
- 62. Check power window operation
- 63. Check sunroof operation (WA)
- 64. Check door locks
- 65. Check map/dome lights
- 66. Check infotainment/navigation system(s) for proper operation

EXIT VEHICLE WITH KEY

- 67. Check rear defogger (warm)
- 68. Check door locks & door closing operation Record key number/security code (WA)
- 69. Check rear seatbelts
- 70. Check security system (WA)
- 71. Check child safety door locks - leave unlocked
- 72. Check door entry lights (WA)

RAISE VEHICLE/VEHICLE ON LIFT

UNDERCARRIAGE INSPECTION - UNDERCARRIAGE DAMAGE AND FLUID LEAKS

(NOTE: REFER TO APPROPRIATE SERVICE MANUAL FOR SAFETY PRECAUTIONS, SPECIFICATIONS AND CORRECT LIFT POINTS)

- 73. Check tire pressure, tread depth, orientation and condition
- 74. Tire set matches? YES NO
- 75. Check wheel, wheel cover, and trim
- 76. Check brakes, rotors, and calipers for specified parameters
- 77. Check wheel cylinders (WA)
- 78. Check axle seals
- 79. Check lug nut torque
- 80. Check for fluid leaks
- 81. Check complete exhaust system
- 82. Check steering linkage
- 83. Check struts
- 84. Check axles
- 85. Check bolts/bushings/fasteners
- 86. Check rear differential fluid level and top off
- 87. Other fluid leaks/damage:

LOWER VEHICLE

ROAD TEST

- 88. Check that the TPMS warning light is not on (WA)
- 89. Check engine performance (cranking, idle, accel., etc.)
- 90. Check transmission performance and warning lights
- 91. Check clutch operation (WA)
- 92. Check clutch safety switch operation (WA)
- 93. Check steering wheel alignment
- 94. Check steering performance (return, free-play, tracking)
- 95. Check for any unusual noises
- 96. Check wheel balance (absence of vibration)
- 97. Check brake operation
- 98. Check gauges/speedometer/odometer operation
and readings
- 99. Check turn signal operation and cancellation
- 100. Check cruise control operation
- 101. Check vent/heater/A/C operation
- 102. Check squeaks, rattles, vibrations, and wind noises
- 103. Check tachometer alarm operation
(reset to "00" when finished) (WA)
- 104. Check Hill Holder operation (WA)
- 105. Check VDC off switch (WA)
- 106. Check that all keys start the engine

POST ROAD TEST

- 107. Parking brake operation
- 108. Check emissions as required by local laws
- 109. Re-check coolant, power steering and ATF levels
- 110. Re-check DTC and remove select monitor,
record and repair if any
- 111. Check for leaks under vehicle
- 112. Check electric cooling fans
